SHARING OUR STORY

On October 18th my sermon explored the popular theme of representatives from more advanced civilizations visiting earth in ancient Mesopotamia and improving our genetic code. The narrative in Genesis launched us deeply into that discussion:

1. When human beings began to increase in number on the earth and daughters were born to them, 2 of the sons of G-d saw that the daughters of humans were beautiful, and they married any of them they chose. 3 Then the Lord said, "My Spirit will not contend with humans forever, for they are mortal; their days will be a hundred and twenty years." (Not 900+ years as they had been up until that point in time)
- 4 The Nephilim were on the earth in those days—and also afterward—when the sons of G-d went to the daughters of humans and had children by them. They were the heroes of old, men of renown.

The talk generated significant interest and sparked engaging discussions afterwards at the kiddish. This shows that our unique perspective and approach can resonate with a wider audience. By sharing our thoughts and ideas with the community, we can attract like-minded individuals who appreciate our synagogue's distinct character.

COMMUNICATING OUR PERSONA

As we enter the month of Heshvan, I'd like to revisit our communication strategy. How can we share our story, values, and experiences with the community more effectively. By leveraging our online presence and sharing summaries of our presentations by members, we can showcase our synagogue's personality.

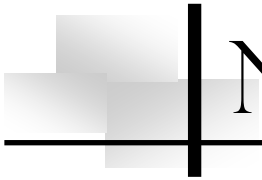
